



## Wedding Time Table for the Bride - 2.00pm Local Wedding Ceremony and Evening Reception

The purpose of this guide is for general guidance only.

Simplified time-table:

**07.30** – Time to get up! Have a relaxing shower or bath.

**08.30** – Time for a good breakfast. Try not to have anything too out of the ordinary otherwise you may end up with an upset stomach!

**09.30** – First visitor of the day – the hairdresser! Time to style your hair.

**10.30** - The photographer arrives for pre-arranged photographs, time for the bride's makeover.

**11.00** - The bridesmaids arrive – time for all to get dressed and hair styled.

**12.30** - The Father of the Bride and page boys arrive. The Best man arrives to collect the luggage / greeting cards if required.

**13.00** - The first wedding car will take the brides mother, bridesmaids and page boys to the church. Guests arrive at church.

**13.30** – Finishing touches, button holes, etc. The second wedding car will take the bride and her father to the church.

**13.55** - The bride and her father will stand at the entrance of the church.

**14.00** - The wedding ceremony.

**15.00** – Wedding photos at church

**16.30** – Bride and Groom Arrive at Wedding Venue

**17.00** – Wedding Dinner

**18:30** – Speeches

**19:00** – Dining area cleared for Reception Celebration

**19.00** – Evening Guests arrive. Background Music.

**20.30** – First Dance

**21.00** – Evening buffet

**21.30** – Reception Disco

**00.00** – Carriages
